## Frido's Treasure Trove

A stimulating memo for 2-4 players from 5-99 years of age.

Frido the Raccoon has returned from a successful treasure hunt and hidden his treasures (goblets, jewels, gold coins and even golden soap dispensers). But, oh dear, now he can't remember where he hid them all.
Can you help Frido find his treasure? The more treasures of different kinds you can find each round (= "treasure hunt"), the more gems he will give you as a finder's reward. Which player will end up with the most gems?

## Contents

1 Frido Raccoon figure, 16 treasure cards, 1 finder's reward card, 50 gems (= finder's rewards), 1 dice, 1 set of instructions

## Game preparation

Shuffle the 16 treasure cards and deal them face down in a circle as shown. Place Frido the Raccoon next to any treasure card in the circle. The gems are piled in the middle of the circle. The finder's reward card is also placed in the center of the circle so that all players can see it. Get the die ready to roll.


## Let's play!

Play proceeds clockwise. The player who last hid a treasure begins the game by rolling the die. Depending on the number rolled, move Frido in a clockwise direction around the circle and turn over the card next to where he lands.


The treasure hunt can now begin!
During each treasure hunt, players are allowed to turn over up to three more cards in succession.
Turn over a treasure card.

## Does this card show the same treasure as the first one?

- No, it shows a different treasure. Sorry, Frido is unable to locate his treasure. Your turn is over, and unfortunately, you haven't earned a finder's
 reward.
- Yes, it shows the same treasure as the first card turned over.



## Great, now you have two options:

1) You can elect to finish your treasure hunt.

In which case, you are allowed to take gems to the value of the finder's reward card.

Or
2) You continue your treasure hunt and turn over another random card in the hope of gaining more gems.

Does this card show the same treasure as the first and the second ones you turned over?

In which case, you have the two options above, and so on.

## The gems are awarded based upon the finder's reward card: <br> 2 identical treasures $=1$ gem <br> 3 identical treasures $=3$ gems <br> 4 identical treasures $=6$ gems <br> HABA <br>  <br> $\square=\square \Rightarrow$ $\square=\square=\square \Rightarrow \theta$ $\square=\square=\square=\square \Rightarrow$ ?

But be careful! If you turn over a card showing a different treasure, your treasure hunt will end immediately and you will not get any gems at all.

It will then be the turn of the next player. He turns any face-up cards down, rolls the dice and moves Frido further around the circle according to the number rolled. He begins his treasure hunt by turning over the card next to where Frido comes to a halt.

## End of game

The game ends as soon as a player collects his or her 13th gem and is declared the winner.
